Eastern Region Section Four Order of the Arrow Proposal to Move Forward with In Person Event Planning



On January 20, 2024, Section E4 hosted the inaugural E4orce Training Conference in a virtual format. This event was a success in its virtual format; however, to continue the mission of providing high quality training to our arrowmen, the virtual format is limited in multiple capacities. Now that we have a proof of concept for quality training, an in person event could be the next step in delivering on our mission of high quality to our arrowmen. An in person format could also provide learners with the opportunities to connect with session facilitators. The preliminary concept proposal for the E4orce Training Conference is as follows:

An in person training weekend, that will be a trial to see if an in person training event would be a beneficial addition to section programming. This style will allow for higher quality trainings that will provide learners with a National Leadership Seminar style experience. Learners will be separated into crews that offer the opportunity for fellowship with scouts across the section. The event could begin with two training sessions Friday night followed by fellowship activities. Saturday morning could have multiple classes with position specific breakouts to better equip lodge leaders with the skills necessary for success. In the afternoon, there can be additional classes followed by an overall section activity. Saturday night could have a closing session and more fellowship opportunities, providing freedom for lodges to plan their departure time at their convenience.

Note: This proposal will be used to reflect the Council of Chief's interest in having an in person training event. If approved and following adult and council/lodge advisor approval/interest, this proposal will serve as the Council of Chief's approval to begin planning for an in person E4orce Training Conference.
